Hair, Makeup, Hygiene, Jewelry, etc.	No change	The policies and expectations in the Parent/Student Handbook have not changed	
Shirts	No Change	Girls' Change to white blouses Boy's Change to white shirts	
Pants	No Change	Khaki/Tan dress or docker-style Navy Blue dress or docker-style	All black pants have been discontinued. Cargo pants have been discontinued.
Shoes	Change	Required black, brown, navy, tan dress shoes (with heel) Sperry style and casual loafers are acceptable.	<b>NO athletic shoes</b>
Socks	No change	Still required	
Polo Shirts	Change	No longer Acceptable	
Sweatshirts and Hoodies	Changed	Not allowed	
Boots	No change	Still not allowed as part of inside-school wear	
New Tie for Boys	Added requirement	Inclusion of an appropriate tie (bowties are okay)	
New Sweater	Added requirements	Each student should have One (1) of the three varieties of sweaters (long-sleeve v-neck; vest; or cardigan)	Each of the sweaters can be purchased from Schoolbelles <sup>1</sup> —see the attached flyer. They can be ordered at the stores or via telephone or the Internet
Book Bags, Backpacks	Changed	They are no longer to be carried during the school day. Materials and bags should be locked in the student's locker.	Team bags and equipment should be stored in their team's designated area.
