Part one: Write a (minimum) one page summary of the book. Make sure to discuss how the relationship between the daughter and mother developed over the course of the novel. Use specifics from the book. This summary should be a minimum 2 paragraphs (for incoming 9th graders) and minimum 3 paragraphs for 10th and 11th grade students.

Part two: Write a (minimum) one page letter to a person in your life you have a broken relationship with. It can be a parent, sibling, or friend. If you cannot think of someone you can write a letter to someone in your life who has passed away. What do you need to say to them? This letter has nothing to do with the book, but since the book is written in letter form I think it would be nice for you to write a letter to someone in your life.
